STATE BOARD MEETING

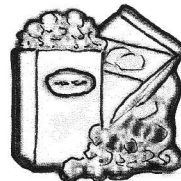
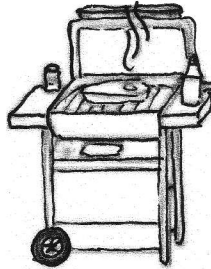
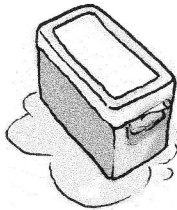
5:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.
